School Goals

- 80% of all K-3rd grade students will reach proficiency on the Acadience assessment by the end of the 2021-2022 school year.
- 85% of all 4th-6th grade students will reach proficiency on the Acadience assessment by the end of the 2021-2022 school year.
- The percentage of students reaching proficiency will increase by 2% in Math RISE tested at the end of the 2021-2022 school year as compared to the 2020-2021 school year. This would result in a 65% passing rate.

District Goals

- **60 percent** of students in grades 1-3 will achieve typical or better growth from BOY to EOY. **Orchard 2020-2021 school year 63%**
- First Grade- By June 1, 2022, Alpine School District will increase the percentage of first-grade students scoring at/above benchmark on Acadience Reading composite from BOY to EOY by 7%.
 Orchard 2020-2021 school year increase by 10.4%

 Second Grade- By June 1, 2022, Alpine School District will maintain or increase the percentage of second-grade students scoring at/above benchmark on the Acadience Reading composite from BOY to EOY. Orchard 2020-2021 school year maintained

- 85% of all 4th-6th grade students will reach proficiency on the Acadience assessment by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.
- 65% of all K-6th grade students will reach proficiency on the math i-Ready assessment by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.

2022-2023 Allocation (\$89334 plus carry over)

Recommended Spending Expenditures

- Classroom and Eagle Time Aides: \$59728
- Subs: \$4100 (Conferences and Data Dive days)
- ❖ Summer Collaboration: 52 Days @ \$225 (Plus benefits (32%) \$3744)= \$15,444
- Conference Fees: \$3000
- ♦ BTS Arts Integration FTE: 20% of .60 Contract= **\$7062**

2021-2022 Trustlands Plan

Orchard Elementary will meet the following goals by implementing ASD's Response to Intervention framework in meeting our student's intervention needs in academic, behavioral and social and emotional well-being.

Goals:

• 78% (80%) of all K-3rd grade students will reach proficiency on the Acadience assessment by the end of the 2021-2022 school year.

- 83% (85%) of all 4th-6th grade students will reach proficiency on the Acadience assessment by the end of the 2021-2022 school year.
- The percentage of students reaching proficiency will increase by 2% in Math RISE tested at the end of the 2021-2022 school year as compared to the 2020-2021 school year. This would result in a 65% passing rate.

2021-2022 Allocation (\$83,662) and Recommended Spending

- Classroom and Eagle Time Aides: \$50831
- Subs: \$4040 (Conferences, PBIS Committee, 3rd grade BER training, 1st grade literacy training)
- Literacy Supplies (3rd grade BER and 1st grade Literacy training): \$800 (8 teachers x \$100)
- ❖ Summer Collaboration: 57 Days @ \$225 (Plus benefits (32%) \$4104)= \$16,929
- ❖ Conference Fees: \$4000
- ♦ BTS Arts Integration FTE: 20% of .60 Contract= \$7062
